

Tree of the year 2004

Malus 'Evereste'

The "Evereste" has been selected as 'Tree of the Year 2004'. It is a cultivar of the Malus deciduous tree. This ornamental apple tree honours its name with a multitude of beautiful red fruits that remain far into the winter season. In the autumn, leaves cling on to the tree for a long time, changing colour from dark green to yellow orange.

The beautiful 6 centimetre long flowers are spread in bunches throughout the tree. Buds are dark purple/pink, and turn to clear white when they open. This extremely attractive flower makes the tree ideal for gardens, parks and public gardens.

A major advantage of the 'Evereste' is its resistance to scab. Furthermore, the tree is free of mildew. It can be cultivated as a tree or a shrub.
