



## Malus toringo var. sargentii



<b>Height</b>	6 m
<b>Width</b>	4-6m
<b>Crown</b>	Irregular sphere, half-open crown, capricious growing
<b>Bark and branches</b>	grey-brown, smooth
<b>Leaf</b>	oval, lobed, glossy dark green, autumn colour golden yellow
<b>Autumn colour</b>	yellow
<b>Flowers</b>	cream white, buds pink, about 2.5 - 3 cm, April/late May, fragrant flowers
<b>Fruits</b>	dark red, turning golden yellow, Ø about 1 cm
<b>Spines/thorns</b>	None
<b>Toxicity</b>	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
<b>Soil type</b>	fertile, well drained soil
<b>Paving</b>	tolerates paving
<b>Winter hardiness zone</b>	5a (-28,8 to -26,1 °C)
<b>Wind resistance</b>	good, susceptible to sea wind
<b>Other resistances</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind
<b>Fauna tree</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind, provides food for birds
<b>Application</b>	narrow streets, tree containers, industrial areas, small gardens, patio gardens
<b>Shape</b>	clearstem tree, multi-stem treem
<b>Origin</b>	Japan

Malus toringo var. sargentii is a small tree with a tangled growth pattern and a rounded crown. Height 6 m. The oval, glossy, dark green leaves are hairy and turn to golden yellow in the autumn. The flower buds are pink. In May the creamy white fragrant flowers open. The small long-stemmed fruits have great ornamental value. They start off dark red but from September to mid-October they turn golden-yellow. Can be used in parks, streets and small gardens. The tree is sensitive to sea wind. Winter hardiness zone: 5a
