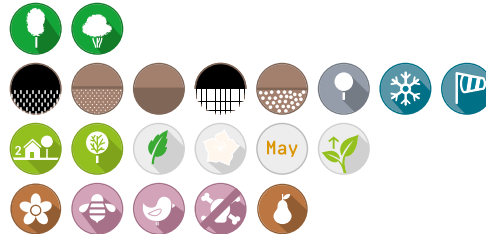




Malus 'Winter Gold'



Height	6-7 m
Width	4-6m
Crown	round/spherical, half-open crown
Bark and branches	brown, grey
Leaf	green
Flowers	pure white, flowers in May
Fruits	yellow
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, acid soil, calcareous soil
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	4 (-34,4 to -28,9 °C)
Wind resistance	good, susceptible to sea wind
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind
Fauna tree	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind, provides food for birds
Application	roof gardens, industrial areas, small gardens, patio gardens
Shape	clearstem tree, multi-stem treem

Malus 'Wintergold' is a sturdy tree with a round crown and a height of 6 - 7 m. The leaves are shiny green and 3 - 5 cleft. The flower buds are pink, opened flowers pure white, 2.5 - 3.5 cm in diameter and single. Flowering is followed by bright yellow fruits, Ø about 1.5 cm, which remain on until January. 'Wintergold' is useful in parks, wide green spaces and small gardens. It has high soil requirements in terms of moisture and soil fertility. 'Golden Hornet' is an improved 'Wintergold'. Hardiness zone: 4
