



## Prunus serrulata 'Jo-nioi'



<b>Height</b>	5-7 m
<b>Width</b>	5-7m
<b>Crown</b>	broad vase-shaped, half-open crown
<b>Bark and branches</b>	brown
<b>Leaf</b>	green, bronze
<b>Autumn colour</b>	orange, red
<b>Flowers</b>	white, flowers in May, fragrant flowers
<b>Fruits</b>	seldom
<b>Spines/thorns</b>	None
<b>Toxicity</b>	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
<b>Soil type</b>	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, calcareous soil
<b>Paving</b>	tolerates no paving
<b>Winter hardiness zone</b>	6a (-23,3 to -20,6 °C)
<b>Wind resistance</b>	fairly
<b>Other resistances</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)
<b>Fauna tree</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), valuable for bees (honey plant)
<b>Application</b>	avenues and broad streets, tree containers, small gardens
<b>Shape</b>	clearstem tree, multi-stem treem

Prunus serrulata 'Jo-nioi' is a healthy grower with a height of up to approx. 7 m. It forms a broad, vase-shaped, flattened crown. The twigs are reddish-brown and have few lenticels. The leaves emerge bronze coloured. The tree flowers in May, before the leaves emerge, producing an abundance of flowers. The white single flowers are in long-stemmed bunches and have a strong and pleasant scent. 'Jo-nioi' seldom bears fruit. The tree is suitable for planting as a park tree and as an avenue tree on wide green verges. It does not stand up to wet soil. Winter hardiness zone: 6a
