



## Tilia platyphyllos 'Prince's Street'



<b>Height</b>	20 m
<b>Crown</b>	broad conical, half-open crown
<b>Bark and branches</b>	grey
<b>Leaf</b>	green
<b>Autumn colour</b>	red
<b>Flowers</b>	cream white, flowers in June, fragrant flowers
<b>Fruits</b>	green, grey
<b>Spines/thorns</b>	None
<b>Toxicity</b>	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
<b>Soil type</b>	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, peaty soil, all soil types
<b>Paving</b>	tolerates partial paving
<b>Winter hardiness zone</b>	4 (-34,4 to -28,9 °C)
<b>Wind resistance</b>	good, susceptible to sea wind
<b>Other resistances</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind
<b>Fauna tree</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind, valuable for butterflies
<b>Application</b>	avenues and broad streets
<b>Shape</b>	clearstem tree

Vigorous large tree with a strong upright growth pattern to over 20 m. The strong upward growth when young keeps it narrow for a long time. Later it forms a pyramidal crown. The young twigs are brownish red, turning bright red in winter like 'Rubra', making the winter aspect very attractive, especially with young trees.
