Pinus banksiana



| Height | 15-20 m |
|-----------------------|---|
| Width | 6-10m |
| Crown | broad conical, half-open crown, capricious growing |
| Bark and branches | silvergrey |
| Leaf | green, greygreen, evergreen |
| Flowers | yellow, flowers in June, fragrant flowers |
| Fruits | brown |
| Spines/thorns | None |
| Toxicity | usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock |
| Soil type | clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, peaty soil, nutrient-poor soil, all soil types |
| Soil moisture | suitable for dry soil |
| Paving | tolerates no paving |
| Winter hardiness zone | 2 (-45,5 to -40,1 °C) |
| Other resistances | resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6) |
| Application | industrial areas |
| Shape | specimen conifer |
