



## Amorpha canescens



<b>Height</b>	0,5-1,5 m
<b>Width</b>	1-2m
<b>Crown</b>	vase-shaped, half-open crown, capricious growing
<b>Bark and branches</b>	grey
<b>Leaf</b>	green, greygreen, feathered leaf
<b>Flowers</b>	blue, violet, flowers in June
<b>Fruits</b>	brown
<b>Spines/thorns</b>	None
<b>Toxicity</b>	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
<b>Soil type</b>	loamy soil, sandy soil, nutrient-poor soil, calcareous soil
<b>Soil moisture</b>	suitable for dry soil
<b>Paving</b>	tolerates no paving
<b>Winter hardiness zone</b>	2 (-45,5 to -40,1 °C)
<b>Other resistances</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)
<b>Fauna tree</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), valuable for butterflies
<b>Application</b>	small gardens, patio gardens
