Amorpha canescens



Height	0,5-1,5 m
Width	1-2m
Crown	vase-shaped, half-open crown, capricious growing
Bark and branches	grey
Leaf	green, greygreen, feathered leaf
Flowers	blue, voilet, flowers in June
Fruits	brown
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	loamy soil, sandy soil, nutrient-poor soil, calcareous soil
Soil moisture	suitable for dry soil
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	2 (-45,5 to -40,1 °C)
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)
Fauna tree	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), valuable for butterflies
Application	small gardens, patio gardens
Application	omat, gardens, patro gardens
