Gleditsia triacanthos STREET KEEPER ('Draves')



| Height | 10 - 13 m |

| Crown | narrow pyramidal, dark, dense crown |
| Bark and branches | branches olive green, thornless, bark grey-brown |
| Leaf | pinnate or bipinnate, glossy dark green, feathered leaf |
| Autumn colour | yellow |
| Flowers | a few light green racemes, june/july |
| Fruits | hardly any, flattened pods, dark reddish brown |
| Spines/thorns | None |
| Toxicity | usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock |
| Soil type | few requirements |
| Soil moisture | suitable for dry soil |
| Paving | tolerates paving |
| Winter hardiness zone | 5a (-28,8 to -26,1 °C) |
| Wind resistance | good |
| Other resistances | resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind, resistant to de-icing salt |
| Fauna tree | resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind, resistant to de-icing salt, valuable for bees (honey plant) |
| Application | avenues and broad streets, narrow streets, roof gardens, industrial areas |
| Shape | clearstem tree, multi-stem treem |

| Synonyms | Gleditsia triacanthos 'Street Keeper' |

Medium-size tree with a narrow pyramidal crown, up to approx. 13 m. Because the trunk grows a straight central leader with little forking, it forms a regular crown. The thornless twigs are olive green, while the older bark is smooth and grey-brown. Grows thicker than other Gleditsia cultivars. The compound leaf emerges late. It is glossy dark green, turning golden yellow in autumn. Does not blossom very profusely, so produces hardly any fruit. Easier to cultivate in comparison to other Gleditsias. Very good street and avenue tree: can grow amid paved surfaces. Also suitable for industrial areas.
