



Magnolia 'Sunray'



Height	8-10 m
Width	6-8m
Crown	ovoid / egg-shaped, dark, dense crown, capricious growing
Bark and branches	brown, grey
Leaf	green
Flowers	soft yellow, flowers in May, fragrant flowers
Fruits	redgreen
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, peaty soil, acid soil
Paving	tolerates partial paving
Winter hardiness zone	6 (-23,3 to -17,8 °C)
Wind resistance	moderate
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)
Fauna tree	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), valuable for bees (honey plant)
Application	tree containers, small gardens, patio gardens
Shape	clearstem tree, multi-stem treem

Fairly slender, vertically growing, small to medium size, usually multi-stemmed tree with an ovoid to broad ovoid crown. Can grow rather vigorously, especially when young, eventually becoming about 8 - 10 m high. The vase-shaped flowers can be over 20 cm across when fully open. They are an even, soft yellow with a dark yellow heart of stamens. On the inside, the petals have a small, red mark at the base. The flowers open around early to mid-May. Originated as a mutant of M. 'Sundance' after colchicine treatment. Suitable for parks and gardens.
