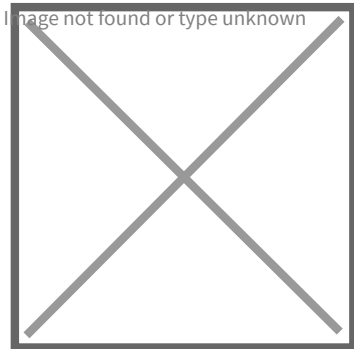




## Platanus ×hispanica

| Height                | 20 - 30 (35) m, fast growing                              |
| Width                 | 18-25m                                                    |
| Crown                 | round, half-open crown                                    |
| Bark and branches     | grey-green and yellow-green flaking bark                  |
| Leaf                  | palmately lobed, green, 12 - 25 cm                        |
| Flowers               | spherical flowering heads, yellow-green, May              |
| Fruits                | spherical, spiky, brown, usually 2 together               |
| Spines/thorns         | None                                                      |
| Toxicity              | usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock   |
| Soil type             | all, soil not too calcareous                              |
| Soil moisture         | withstand short flood, withstand long flood               |
| Paving                | tolerates paving                                          |
| Winter hardiness zone | 6a (-23,3 to -20,6 °C)                                    |
| Wind resistance       | moderate to good                                          |
| Other resistances     | resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), resistant to de-icing salt |
| Application           | avenues and broad streets                                 |
| Shape                 | clearstem tree, multi-stem treem                          |
| Origin                | Oxford, England, ca. 1670                                 |
| Synonyms              | Platanus hybrida, Platanus ×acerifolia                    |
