| Height | 20-25 m |
| Width | 12-18m |
| Crown | broad conical, half-open crown |
| Bark and branches | grey |
| Leaf | green |
| Autumn colour | red |
| Flowers | gold-coloured, flowers in May |
| Fruits | brown |
| Spines/thorns | None |
| Toxicity | usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock |
| Soil type | loamy soil, sandy soil, peaty soil, calcareous soil |
| Soil moisture | suitable for wet soil |
| Paving | tolerates no paving |
| Winter hardiness zone | 6b (-20,5 to -17,8 °C) |
| Other resistances | resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), resistant to de-icing salt |
| Application | avenues and broad streets, industrial areas |
| Shape | clearstem tree |
