Rhus typhina 'Dissecta'



Height	6-8 m, fast growing
Width	5-9m
Crown	broad vase-shaped, half-open crown, capricious growing
Bark and branches	grey, reddisch brown
Leaf	green, feathered leaf
Autumn colour	yellow, orange, red
Flowers	yellowgreen, flowers in July
Fruits	red
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, peaty soil, nutrient-poor soil, acid soil, all soil types
Soil moisture	suitable for dry soil
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	4 (-34,4 to -28,9 °C)
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)
Fauna tree	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), valuable for butterflies
Application	industrial areas, small gardens, patio gardens
Shape	clearstem tree, multi-stem treem
