



## Rhus typhina 'Dissecta'

| <b>Height</b>                | 6-8 m, fast growing  |
| <b>Width</b>                 | 5-9m   |
| <b>Crown</b>                 | broad vase-shaped, half-open crown, capricious growing   |
| <b>Bark and branches</b>     | grey, reddish brown  |
| <b>Leaf</b>                  | green, feathered leaf  |
| <b>Autumn colour</b>         | yellow, orange, red  |
| <b>Flowers</b>               | yellowgreen, flowers in July   |
| <b>Fruits</b>                | red  |
| <b>Spines/thorns</b>         | None   |
| <b>Toxicity</b>              | usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock  |
| <b>Soil type</b>             | clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, peaty soil, nutrient-poor soil, acid soil, all soil types |
| <b>Soil moisture</b>         | suitable for dry soil  |
| <b>Paving</b>                | tolerates no paving  |
| <b>Winter hardiness zone</b> | 4 (-34,4 to -28,9 °C)  |
| <b>Other resistances</b>     | resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)  |
| <b>Fauna tree</b>            | resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), valuable for butterflies  |
| <b>Application</b>           | industrial areas, small gardens, patio gardens   |
| <b>Shape</b>                 | clearstem tree, multi-stem treem   |
